To raise money for the Children's Oncology Group at the Medical College of Georgia Children's Medical Center where Coach Pawlowski's daughter Mary-Louise is receiving her cancer treatments. In December 2007 at age 13 Mary-Louise was diagnosed with a primitive neuroectodermal tumor (PNET), a rare malignancy seen in only 2% of children with cancer.
